1924: State Health Department

1964: Governor's Public Health Advisory Committee

1967: Local Health Act

1970s: Guidelines for minimum local board of health responsibilities

1988: Institute of Medicine Report: No citizen should be without access to the benefits of public health protection through a local public health delivery system

1990s: Public Health Charter

MODERN(IZATION) TIMES

2003-2004: Regional meetings indicate a need for action
