

IS-400: Advanced ICS Command and General Staff – Complex Incidents

Institution: FEMA

Course Description: This course provides training on and resources for personnel who require advanced application of the Incident Command System (ICS). This course expands upon information covered in ICS-100, ICS-200, and ICS-300 courses. The prerequisite for ICS-400 is ICS-100, ICS-200, and ICS-300.

Course Objectives: Explain how major incidents engender special management challenges, describe the circumstances in which an Area Command is established, and describe the circumstances in which multi-agency coordination systems are established.
